

JUNIOR PRIDE AWARD

The Junior PRIDE Award is designed to develop the leadership skills of our junior students. It is based on the philosophy of reinforcing positive behaviour by recognising and demonstrating to students the type of behaviours Heretaunga College values.

Students collect points to earn a bronze then silver then gold PRIDE lapel badge. To earn points, students have to consistently demonstrate the school PRIDE values of Participation, Respect, Integrity, Determination and Excellence. It recognises positive contributions that students have made both in school and the wider community. Students on their Gold badge may then apply for a PRIDE Leadership badge.

The programme is run by Year 12 and 13 Peer support leaders. They each mentor a small group of students and help them to become actively involved in school and community activities.
